



Gender Identity Discrimination is Against the Law **Discrimination Based on Gender Identity or Expression is Against New York State Law** In January 2019, the New York State Human Rights Law was amended to add gender identity or expression as a protected category. Discrimination on the basis of gender identity or expression is prohibited in all areas covered by the Human Rights Law, including employment, housing, places of public accommodation, and schools.
