

DIRECTIONS TO THE SYRACUSE REGIONAL OFFICE

John H. Hughes State Office Building, 333 East Washington St., Room 543

THE JOHN H. HUGHES STATE OFFICE BUILDING is located in Syracuse,
Coming from:

NORTH: Take 81 South towards Syracuse to Exit 19, Clinton St/Salina St. Turn slight left to take the Salina St. Ramp. Turn slight right onto N. Salina Street. Turn left onto East Washington Street.

SOUTH: Take 81 North to Exit 18 (Adams Street Exit). Stay straight on Almond Street. Left on Genessee/NY-92. Right on S. State St/US-11. Left onto East Washington St.

EAST: Take I-90W/Thruway to Exit 34A and merge onto 481 South. Take Exit 4 (690 West). Take the Townsend Street Exit, Exit 13. Left on N. Townsend Right on NY-5/Erie Blvd E. Left onto S. State St/US 11. Right on E. Washington Street

WEST: Take I-90E/Thruway to Exit 39 to and merge onto 690 East. Take the W Genessee St Exit, Exit 12. Left onto W. Genessee St. Right on N. Salina St. Left on East Washington Street.

BY TRAIN: Call Amtrak at the toll free number (1-800-872-7245) for schedule and time.

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION: Take any regular route to Fayette and Salina; walk one block north to East Washington Street, then two and a half blocks east to the John H. Hughes State Office Building OR, to avoid the walk, take the #410, #110, or #310, which have stops on a corner nearest the building.

ACCESS FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

Mobility disabilities: For handicap accessible parking, drive to the back of the building off Water Street, pull up to parking gate, and use intercom to request access to the parking lot. Use the east side door with the ramp, then press buzzer for entry; elevators will take you to the fifth floor. Paratransit, medical transportation vehicles, and taxis can also access back door; driver should approach gate and use intercom to request access.

Blind and visually impaired: Use front or back entrance, front entrance has stairs. For entry with ramp, use east door; entry after ramp is via buzzer system (button is on the right side of second set of doors.) Elevator buttons are in raised numbers and in Braille markings; automatic voice announces floors. If you need assistance, call the office at 315-428-4633 for arrangements.

Deaf and hearing impaired: Use front or back entrance, front entrance has stairs. For entry with ramp, use east door; entry after ramp is via buzzer system. Press button three times in rapid succession to summon security officer; repeat if necessary. Front door does not require use of buzzer. If desired, advance arrangements can be made by contacting the office at 315-428-4633 via relay service.
